Transition Policy ISO 27001:2022

ISO 27001- Information security Management System (ISMS) – is revised and published the latest ISO 27001:2022 (dt 25th October 2022) as the third edition-Information security, cybersecurity, and privacy protection — Information security management systems. There are no major changes in the requirements of clauses. The Key Changes in ISO 27001:2022 vs ISO 27001:2013 is given below.

Key Changes in ISO 27001:2022 vs ISO 27001:2013

- Annex A references the controls in ISO/IEC 27002:2022, which includes the information on control title and control
- The notes of Clause 6.1.3 c) are revised editorially, including deleting the control objectives and using "information security control" to replace "control";
- The wording of Clause 6.1.3 d) is re-organized to remove the potential ambiguity
- Compared with the old edition (ISO 27001:2013), the number of controls in ISO/IEC 27002:2022 decreases from 114 controls in 14 clauses to 93 controls in 4 clauses. For the controls in ISO/IEC 27002:2022, 11 controls are new, 24 controls are merged from the existing controls, and 58 controls are updated. Moreover, the control structure is revised, which introduces "attribute" and "purpose" for each control and no longer uses "objective" for a group of controls

Validity of Certification of ISO 27001:2013

ISO 27001:2013 certification will not be valid after 31/10/2025 (i.e 36 months from the Last publication month of ISO 27001:2022) (i.e 25th October 2022).

ISO 27001:2022 Transition process and Requirements

All the ISO 27001:2013 Certified Clients, who want to get Transition to ISO 27001:2022. The requirements for ISO 27001:2022 transition are given below (but not limited)

- The gap analysis of ISO/IEC 27001:2022, as well as the need for changes to the ISMS
- Provide Training on new Changes of ISO 27001:2022 to all the key personnel and Staff
- The updating of the statement of applicability (SoA)
- If applicable, the updating of the risk treatment plan

Transition Policy ISO 27001:2022

- The implementation and effectiveness of the new or changed controls.
- Make the necessary changes in documents and procures
- Perform the Internal Audit and Management review meeting
- Submit the Application for Transition Audit of ISO 27001:2022 to OSS, at least 15 days in advance of the Surveillance Audit or Re-Certification Audit due date.
- Additional 0.5 Man-day additional auditor day will apply for Transition Audit of ISO 27001:2022

Note:

If the certified client has not completed the Transition of ISO 27001:2022 on or before 31st October 2025.

The Old certification will Expire (ISO 27001:2013)

After the 31st of October 2025, clients want certification of ISO 27001 – It will be Treated as New Application and shall be handled as per the New Case ISO 27001 certification Process.
